Re: Pupil Premium

I pray you are well and in the very best of health.

Due the COVID-19 pandemic or otherwise, your personal circumstances may have changed. This may include an entitlement for free school meals for your child and eligibility for the school to include you in our pupil premium consideration. This would be dependent on if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits below.

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

In addition to a regular free School meal pupil premium funding is used by schools in a variety of ways to support learning and enrichment such as;

- Targeted support for teaching and learning to raise attainment and progress
- Personal wellbeing mentor
- Subsidised school equipment and enrichment trips to support personal wellbeing and education
- Career guidance to support higher aspiration
- Parent and carers support with local authority and action groups
- Breakfast club and Parent carer coffee mornings

Please note that, should your circumstances change, and you no longer qualify or are in receipt of any of the above benefits, pupil premium funding eligibility will still continue for your child for a further 6 years from the time of commencement.

If your child is currently receiving free School meals, there is no need to complete this form. If you believe your child may qualify, please complete the enclosed application form by
